- Provide instruction using Character Strong's PurposeFull People lessons in alignment with the Comprehensive School Counseling Program to support social emotional development of students

- Systematically collect and review data to track social emotional and behavioral trends of students to inform intervention decisions aligned with the Comprehensive School Counseling Plan
- Elevate student's voices and provide leadership opportunities to deter negative or disengaged behaviors

- School-wide staff collaboration around data, grouping, and identification of student needs for Tier 2 interventions
- Provide instruction and support for school-wide, Tier 2 interventions to address behavioral and social emotional needs
